Welcome to EverThrive IL's 2023 Annual Benefit!

This evening is special because it is an opportunity to come together and celebrate our collective achievements and renew our commitment to being Champions for Health Equity. We are working together toward an equitable and affirming health

care ecosystem where Illinoisans, especially those in Black, Brown, Indigenous, and LGBTOIA communities, can build and care for their families on their terms.

Now more than ever EverThrive Illinois' work is vital to creating healthy communities in Illinois. Birthing people living in under resourced communities are experiencing additional stressors like food, housing, and health care insecurity. Black communities, regardless of class, continue to be disproportionately impacted by health injustice. Recently, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released their latest report on U.S. Maternal Mortality Rates, showing a sharp increase in Black maternal deaths in 2021—a rate that remains twice as high as white women. Our health care systems continue to fail our most vulnerable populations, and it is unacceptable.

EverThrive Illinois believes all birthing people and infants in our state should have positive health outcomes that are not determined or impacted by their race, ethnicity, class, identity, or immigration status. We create community-centered solutions to support positive health outcomes for communities most impacted by health injustice. We will also continue working with our community partners to ensure individuals and families have the access, resources, and health care necessary to sustain healthy families on their own terms.

This work would not be possible without strong partnerships. I want to thank our sponsors, board members, host committee, associate board, and donors for their support today and throughout the year.

ABOUT EVERTHRIVE ILLINOIS

The choice to have and raise a healthy family is a human right. Sadly, not all families have the same access to resources and opportunities to thrive. For more than 30 years, EverThrive Illinois has been advancing the health and safety of Illinoisans by supporting access to quality health care and providing resources to achieve health equity. During this time, our focus has broadened from coverage for pregnant people to addressing the wide range of factors that can impact the health of parents, children, and communities.

Today, we strive to affirm and center the experiences and voices of communities most impacted by injustice to achieve reproductive justice for all people and families—especially those in Black,



Brown, Indigenous, and LGBTQIA communities. We ensure they have the access, resources, and health care necessary to create and sustain healthy families on their own terms.

EverThrive Illinois is committed to working in solidarity with— and being accountable to—people on the ground through community-driven partnerships, policy action, and systems-change projects. This collective effort advances our shared priorities of eliminating racial and gender disparities in care and creating a health care system that is deserving of trust from those most affected by injustices.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

ACHIEVE BIRTH EQUITY

We will ensure that pregnant and postpartum people in Black and Brown communities receive the high-quality care and services they need to have safe and healthy births.

INCREASE VACCINE CONFIDENCE

We will provide community-centered education to address the root causes of vaccine reluctance, including systemic racism in the health care system that breeds mistrust.

EXPAND ACCESS TO COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH CARE

We will secure high-quality health insurance for all people and the holistic health care they need to thrive. We will also partner with health care and social service professionals to close the gaps.

LIVE OUR VALUES

We will increase our staff capacity, resource development, and board effectiveness, centering our values in our organizational practices to achieve greater impact and strengthen our leadership statewide.



WHY INVEST IN EVERTHRIVE IL?

CREATING EQUITABLE HEALTH OUTCOMES REQUIRES COLLECTIVE ACTION AND ATTENTION.

Creating a health care ecosystem that uplifts the experiences and care of people most impacted by health injustices requires statewide action and participation. Everyone, from parents to policymakers and organizational partners, has a role in making reproductive justice a reality. Your donation helps us continue educating, organizing, and developing equitable health solutions.

Our efforts have achieved real results that impact the lives of Illinoisans every day. For example:

- Last year, EverThrive IL reached 6,289 individuals through our community outreach, provider trainings, and coalition work.
- Trained 91 social service providers on the maternal mortality crisis and identified opportunities for community-based organizations to support pregnant and postpartum people in communities.
- Developed and launched our COVID-19 digital campaign that reached 234,302 people and focused on debunking myths and encouraging families, pregnant people, and caregivers to get vaccinated.
- Consulted with ten birthing hospitals in Illinois on patient and community engagement strategies.
- Produced a community-centered campaign called "The Gathering" to help pregnant and postpartum people in areas with high maternal mortality and morbidity rates understand postpartum warning signs and better advocate for themselves with health care providers. This campaign responded to findings from 330 surveys.
- Hosted four successful Maternal and Child Health Virtual Town
 Halls with over 760 attendees. The town halls focused on the
 impact that housing insecurity, substance abuse, treatment, not
 getting the COVID-19 vaccine, and Medicaid health plans have on
 pregnant and postpartum people.

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



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
