

Immunization Recommendations for 2025–2026 Respiratory Virus Season

Age/Condition	Flu	RSV	COVID-19
 Children	All 6 months to 17 years of age	- All infants under the age of 8 months whose mothers did not receive RSV vaccine during pregnancy - Certain children ages 8–19 months who are at increased risk for severe RSV disease	- All children ages 6–23 months - All children ages 2–17 years with at least one risk factor for severe disease including those in special situations* - Children with weakened immune systems - Children whose parents or guardians want them to get a COVID-19 vaccine
 Pregnancy	All	All pregnant people during weeks 32–36 of pregnancy	All, including after delivery and during breastfeeding
 Adults	All 18 years and older	- Adults ages 50–74 years at increased risk of severe RSV disease - All adults ages 75 years and older	All 18 years and older

**Other special situations include: Residents of long-term care facilities or other congregate settings; Persons who have never been vaccinated against COVID-19; Persons whose household contacts are at high risk for severe COVID-19.*
